Job Site Safety

The steel members are obviously a non-self-supporting steel frame "Temporary Support of Structural Steel Frames," in the AISC *Code of Standard Practice* states The erector must furnish adequate temporary supports as required by the *Code*. The erector is also governed by Section 1710(a), "Bracing" of the *Construction Safety*. An analysis of OSHA data shows that steel erection accidents resulting in fatalities are often caused by the following factors:

Collapses while landing or placing a load Improper use or failure of fall protection
